

LEED-CI and Flooring

LEARN TO LEED WITH MANNINGTON

Listed below are the LEED-CI credits to which Mannington products can potentially contribute. *Note: No single product, by itself, obtains a LEED Credit with the exception of Low-Emitting Materials, Credit 4.1 (see below). Products can, in aggregate, contribute to attaining credits.*

Materials & Resources

- > **Divert 50% of Construction Waste from Landfill** **Credit 2.1** **1 point**
Divert 75% of Construction Waste from Landfill **Credit 2.2** **1 point**
Requirement: Recycle and/or salvage at least 50% for one credit or 75% for two of construction, demolition and land clearing waste.
Mannington: Our carpet can be reclaimed; contact us for information.
- > **Recycled Content – 10%** **Credit 4.1** **1 point**
Recycled Content – 20% **Credit 4.2** **1 point**
Requirement: Use materials with recycled content; post-consumer + 1/2 of pre-consumer content = 10% for one credit or 20% for two of the total value of the materials in the project.
Mannington: Many of our flooring products contain recycled content. Percentages provided upon request.
- > **Regional Materials – 20% Manufactured Regionally** **Credit 5.1** **1 point**
Requirement: Use a minimum of 20% of building materials and products that are manufactured regionally within a radius of 500 miles.
Mannington: Our carpet is manufactured in Calhoun, Georgia; hard-surface flooring is manufactured in Salem, New Jersey.
- > **Regional Materials – 10% Extracted Regionally** **Credit 5.2** **1 point**
Requirement: Use a minimum of 10% of building materials and products extracted, harvested or recovered, as well as manufactured, within 500 miles of the project.
Mannington: 85% by weight of our VCT consists of limestone extracted within 500 miles of Salem, New Jersey.
- > **Rapidly Renewable Materials** **Credit 6** **1 point**
Requirement: Use rapidly renewable building materials and products for 2.5% of the total value of all building materials and products used in the project, based on cost.
Mannington: We offer flooring made from fast-growing bamboo.

Indoor Environmental Quality

- > **Adhesives and Sealants** **Credit 4.1** **1 point**
Requirement: The VOC content of adhesives and sealants used must be less than the current VOC content limits of South Coast Air Quality Management District (SCAQMD) Rule #1168, and all aerosol adhesives must meet the Green Seal Standard GS-36 requirements in effect on October 19, 2000.
Mannington: All our commercial adhesives meet these criteria.
- > **Low-Emitting Materials – Carpet Systems** **Credit 4.3** **1 point**
Requirement: Carpet must meet or exceed the Carpet and Rug Institute's (CRI) Green Label Plus IAQ Test Program. Additionally, carpet adhesive must meet the requirements of EQ Credit 4.1, a VOC limit of 50 g/L. FloorScore products can also be used. A minimum of 25% of the finished floor area (both carpet and non-carpet areas) of a building must be comprised of non-carpet floor products, and all of these non-carpet floor products must be FloorScore certified.
Mannington: All our running-line carpets and most of our custom carpets meet Green Label Plus requirements. All commercial sheet and tile products meet FloorScore requirements.
- > **Indoor Chemical and Pollutant Source Control** **Credit 5** **1 point**
Requirement: Employ permanent entryway systems to capture dirt, particulates, etc. from entering the building at all high-volume exterior entryways within the tenant area. (One of four criteria for the point.)
Mannington: Our Ruffian/Ruffian Ridge and Recoarse flooring fulfills this part of the credit.
